Jesus Is Better

Hebrews 1-8

STORY POINT: JESUS, OUR GREAT HIGH PRIEST, BROUGHT A BETTER COVENANT.

The early church was made up of believers who were persecuted for following Jesus. Because their lives had become difficult, many believers began to wonder if following Jesus was worth it. The Holy Spirit helped a Christian leader write words of encouragement to the early church in the Book of Hebrews. He wrote:

"Long ago, God spoke to His people through prophets. Now He speaks through Jesus. Jesus is God the Son, and He is like God in every way.

"Jesus humbled Himself to become lower than the angels for a time when He became a man. Jesus became a person like us to die and then rise again. Jesus' work rescues people from sin. All who believe in Him become His brothers and sisters. Because Jesus suffered and was tempted, He is able to help us when we are tempted.


"This is why Jesus is the greatest!

He is greater than Moses, who was a faithful servant of God. Jesus was an even better servant. Jesus knows our weaknesses because He became a human and was tempted, although He never sinned. Because of Jesus, we can approach God with boldness; and God will give us mercy and grace. This is why Jesus is better than anything and why we cannot turn away from Him. Salvation is found only in Jesus!"

Christ Connection: Jesus is better than anyone and anything. He is the better Prophet, the better Priest, and the better King. Everyone who trusts in Jesus has salvation from sin through His perfect life, death, and resurrection.
